In this two-part workshop, parents/caregivers will learn about the ABC's of behaviour.

In **Part 1,** we identify behaviours that interfere with everyday activities. We will also explore how parents can gather information about the interfering behaviour and develop prevention strategies. In **Part 2**, we look at why interfering behaviours happen and the strategies to help manage them on a daily basis. Parents/caregivers identify alternative behaviours to teach their child and develop a plan to target a specific interfering behaviour. This is a partnership with Ontario Early Years Centres.

Please note: that we cannot address more severe interfering behaviours such as self-injurious behaviour (e.g., hits own head) or aggression that causes physical harm to others.
