Jumping Jellyfish is a 6-week specialized swim program for preschoolers with special needs. The program will be running off site, giving us a chance to explore a community location. Children will explore swim readiness and basic swim skills such as safe participation, pool entry and exit, floatation and specialized equipment with the goal of community participation. The program will be facilitated by TVCC therapists.

The Stoneycreek YMCA's pool temperature is 86 degrees and they have large, fully accessible change rooms. Parent/caregiver **must** accompany their child in the water. The pool depth is 0.8m so to support your child in the water; parents will be bending down or sitting on the pool floor.
