Children with special needs will take a peek at typical kindergarten activities and routines each day. This program is designed for children who have not had a previous preschool experience. There will be opportunities for children to practice social, language, fine motor skills and gross motor skills that are connected to kindergarten activities. Support to enhance student success will be provided by TVCC clinicians and volunteers. **Parents** will participate in group discussions about kindergarten, preparation for transitions, school processes, parent/school relationships and curriculum. Parents will have an opportunity to view video tape of their child participating in the program. Guest speakers from the school boards and the TVCC school aged program will be available to share information and answer questions.
