- A workshop called "What is ABA?" will introduce you to the ABA-based approach and techniques you can incorporate into your daily interactions.
- Next, a series of comprehensive Education Workshops can increase knowledge and skills that are beneficial when working with children or youth with autism spectrum disorders.
- At the end of the training, those who work with children/youth with ASD through this initiative are offered guidance and support from a skilled ABA-based Facilitator, to integrate ABA-based strategies to help children learn, maintain and generalize newly acquired skills.
