What?

Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA)-based services and supports for children and youth with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) provides information and education on ABA strategies you can use with your child in addition to:

- A collaborative process to identify one priority goal for your child/youth with ASD in one of four areas of development: daily living skills, communication, social/interpersonal and behaviour management
- Community service providers trained in the use of ABA-based techniques who incorporate strategies into direct services and supports for your child/youth with ASD
- Consultation and guidance to help you use ABA-based techniques with your child/youth
- Services offered between 2-4 hours per week for 2-6 months in individual or group settings and in various locations

Why?

To assist children/youth with ASD to participate fully at home and in their community

Bruce, Chatham-Kent, Elgin, Essex, Grey, Huron, Lambton, Middlesex, Oxford and Perth counties

Who?

Children and youth with a written confirmed diagnosis of ASD, under 18 years old, living in Southwestern Ontario
