Additional Information: Actors must bring their speech generating device that will be used throughout the week for communication. TVCC ACS clinicians will provide tech support and training for the Original Kids.

Setting the Stage is a half-day morning camp for children/youth who are learning to use Speech Generating Devices and who need lots of opportunities to develop their communication skills. Older children will be considered, on a case by case basis, depending on their communication abilities.

Participants ("actors") will be supported by youth from the Original Kids Theatre Company in a variety of theatre based games and activities, and will rehearse and perform three short play adaptations, which will be presented to an audience of family and friends on the final day of camp.
