FOUNDATIONAL FAMILY SERVICES

Foundational Family Services are a broad range of services and supports designed to help parents and caregivers learn how to support their child or youth with autism.

Foundational Family Services are open to all families of children or youth registered in the Ontario Autism Program.

CAREGIVER-MEDIATED EARLY YEARS*

Caregiver-Mediated Early Years programs support families with young children (aged 12 to 48 months) diagnosed with autism to learn new skills and meet individualized goals.

In the caregiver-mediated model, parents and caregivers learn therapeutic strategies and specific techniques from professionals based on their child's individual needs.

ENTRY TO SCHOOL*

Entry to School is a two-part program for young children prior to starting kindergarten or grade one for the first time.

For the first six months, the program focuses on skill-building and school readiness skills. The program continues for six more months to support the child's transition into school and provide consultation to families and educators.

CORE CLINICAL SERVICES*

Individual and group treatment for children and youth with autism, delivered in an integrated way with progress overseen by a Registered Behaviour Analyst. Core Clinical Services (CCS) may be purchased using OAP funding, other MCCSS sources, or Jordan's Principle funds. As soon as you have confirmed eligible funding, please let us know so we can get you started in CCS!
