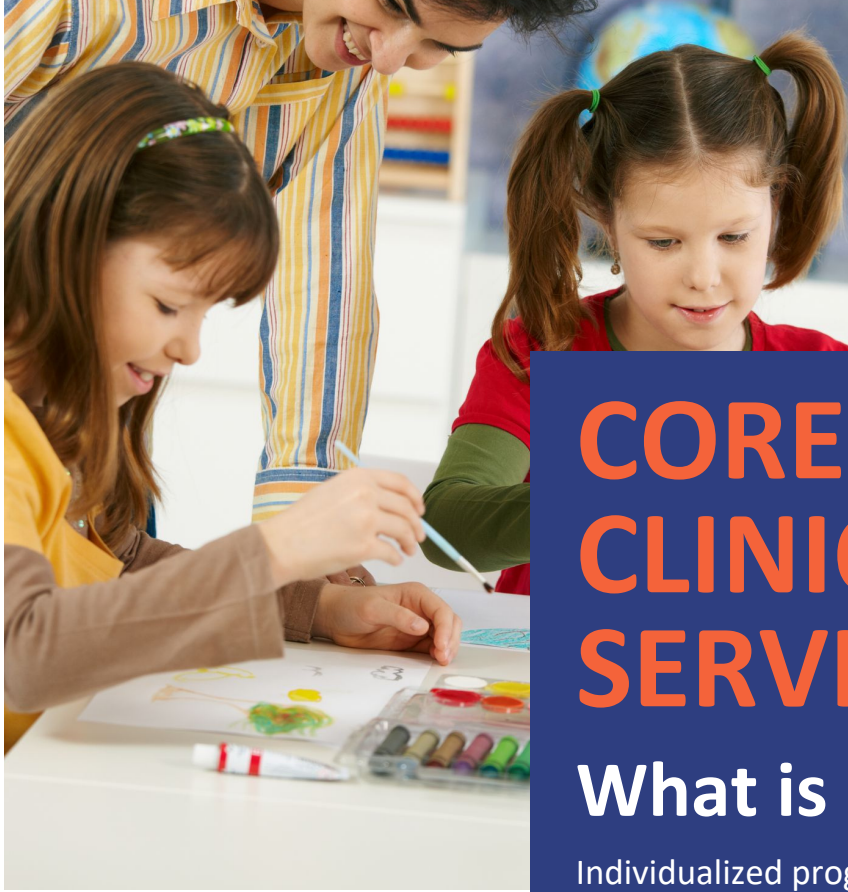




CORE CLINICAL SERVICES (CCS)

What is CCS?

Individualized programming designed specifically to meet the needs of your child or youth based on your family's preferences and goals. Individual and group programs are available and overseen by a Registered Behaviour Analyst (BA).



Who is it for?

Children and youth up to the age of 18:

- With an ASD diagnosis
- Registered with the Ontario Autism Program (OAP) with Access OAP
- Received eligible public funding (i.e., OAP, other MCCSS sourced, or Jordan's Principle funds)
