


## **Going to the Dentist**

When I get to the dentist office, I might need to wait. I can play with toys, read a book, or play on the iPad. I wait in the waiting room until it is my turn.




When it is my turn, the dental hygienist will come and call my name.

The dentist will give me glasses to protect my eyes. I open my mouth wide so the dentist can look at my teeth.




The dentist might use something cool to open my mouth wider! This will make it easier to clean my teeth.
