

Fitzgerald Key Colour Coding

Colour coding is used to learn word categories, to aid in locating specific symbols/words and to facilitate the development of grammar. As new symbols/words are added they should be consistent with the existing organization. This will make learning and using new vocabulary easier. Symbols/words should be presented in the standard organization and colour coding as follows:

SOCIAL PINK/PURPLE

(polite, apologetic, polite words)

PEOPLE YELLOW

(including personal pronouns)

VERBS GREEN

(action words)

DESCRIPTIVE BLUE

(adjectives, adverbs)

NOUNS ORANGE

(places, things)

MISCELLANEOUS BLACK

(articles, conjunctions, prepositions, time, colours, alphabet, numbers) 4)35.
