







Fitzgerald Key Colour Coding

Colour coding is used to learn word categories, to aid in locating specific symbols/words and to facilitate the development of grammar. As new symbols/words are added they should be consistent with the existing organization. This will make learning and using new vocabulary easier. Symbols/words should be presented in the standard organization and colour coding as follows:

<p>SOCIAL (<u>polite</u>, apologetic, polite words)</p>	<p>PINK/PURPLE</p>	
<p>PEOPLE (<u>including</u> personal pronouns)</p>	<p>YELLOW</p>	
<p>VERBS (<u>action</u> words)</p>	<p>GREEN</p>	
<p>DESCRIPTIVE (<u>adjectives</u>, adverbs)</p>	<p>BLUE</p>	
<p>NOUNS (places, things)</p>	<p>ORANGE</p>	
<p>MISCELLANEOUS (articles, conjunctions, prepositions, time, <u>colours</u>, alphabet, numbers)</p>	<p>BLACK</p>
