Thames Valley Children's Centre is the Single Point of Access for the Ontario Autism Program (OAP). All people under the age of 18 with a diagnosis of ASD are eligible for the OAP. At TVCC, we provide workshops and presentations for caregivers to learn skills to help their child/youth. You can access these before your child has a diagnosis of autism, while you are on the OAP Wait List, or while you are in direct service with a clinician.



Why?

To help parents/caregivers learn the skills to help their child learn new things

Where?

Bruce, Chatham-Kent, Elgin, Essex, Grey, Huron, Lambton, Middlesex, Oxford and Perth counties.

Who?

Children and youth (up to age 18) with a written confirmed diagnosis of ASD, and their families.
